

St. Lucas Uniform Policy

The Lord has blessed us with a great school and a wonderful opportunity to learn about our Savior and the world He created. We want to share these blessings of faith and education with those around us.

It is important to have a cohesive and positive school identity as we welcome visitors into our community. The following uniform has been developed to enable the entire student body to be a visible representation of the St. Lucas School Spirit, identifying themselves as St Lucas Lancers. We pray this uniform will positively affect our school campus and the interaction between our students and our community.

Our Teachers and school administration are counting on the support of the families of the students attending St. Lucas School in implementing this uniform. The staff will use its good judgment to determine when clothing and accessories do not fit the uniform policy and or safety becomes an issue. The same holds true if a situation occurs that is not specifically addressed in the uniform policy.

Students are **required** to dress in uniform as listed below during the school day. Field Trip dress code will be announced by teachers on a trip by trip basis.

--Clothing Items for this dress code can be easily purchased at any retailer's uniform section as long as it is dress code appropriate.--

-SHIRTS-

All shirts worn to St. Lucas must have sleeves and a collar. Shirts must extend from the collar bone to beyond the waist. Shirts must be buttoned. Shirts with tails must be tucked in. Solid color long sleeve shirts/turtlenecks may be worn under the collared shirt for added warmth. Shirts with Brand Logos (i.e. Nike, Old Navy) must be smaller than a fist.

Unacceptable

Shirts with Prints, Patterns, Logos ,Plaids
Crew-necks or V-necks / Shirts without collars

-SWEATERS/VESTS/PULLOVERS/CARDIGANS-

Sweaters, vests, pullovers and cardigans will be allowed to be worn over the school uniform. Brand Logos (i.e. Nike, Old Navy) must smaller than a fist

PANTS-

Pants must be Solid Black, Solid Navy Blue, Solid Dark Brown, or Solid Khaki Color.

Twill Pants (chinos)
Corduroy Pants
Cargo Pants
Dress Pants

Unacceptable

Denim of any color
"Skinny Pants"/ "Jeggings" [Tight, Form Fitting Pants]
Athletic Pants
Pants with Holes or Frayed cuffs
Baggy Pants
Leggings worn as Pants

-SHORTS-

Shorts may be worn until September 30th, and after May 1st. Shorts must be Solid Black, Solid Navy Blue, Solid Dark Brown, or Solid Khaki Color.

Acceptable

Shorts must be 2 inches above knee or longer
Pleated or Plain Front
Capri Pants for Girls

Unacceptable

Denim of any color
Athletic Shorts / Boxers / Spandex
Shorts with Holes or Frayed cuffs
Baggy Shorts

-SKORTS, SKIRTS, JUMPERS, DRESSES

Skorts, skirts, jumpers and dresses must be Solid Black, Solid Navy Blue, Solid Dark Brown or Solid Khaki Color.

Acceptable

Skirts must be 2 inches above knee or longer

Dresses must have collars

Girls may wear tights, nylons, leggings, or socks with skorts, skirts, jumpers and dresses

Unacceptable

Denim of any color

-SHOES-

Footwear must ensure safety on the playground.

Acceptable

Velcro Strap Shoes

Tennis/Athletic Shoes

Flats

Flat Heeled Boots

Unacceptable

Clogs

Flip Flops

Shoes with Raised Heels

Open Toe Shoes

Slippers

Sandals with Strap around Heel

-HAIR/HATS-

Hair must be neat, clean, well groomed, and a natural color. Hairstyles must be kept in moderation and not cause distractions.

Unacceptable

Hair in the Eyes

(BOYS) Hair below the Collar

Mohawks/Tails/Spiked

Santa Hats

-MAKE-UP-

Light Make-up is allowed for Girls in 7th and 8th Grade.

Unacceptable

Any Dark or Heavily worn Make-up

(BOYS) Any Make-Up / Nail Polish

-JEWELRY-

Girls are allowed to wear a moderate amount of jewelry. For physical education class and athletic competition, the rules do not allow participants to wear jewelry of any kind.

Unacceptable

Excessive Jewelry

Dangle/ Hoop Earrings

Gauges

ANY jewelry considered offensive in language, art, slogans, etc

(BOYS) Earrings

Uniform clothing that your child has outgrown, and which is in good condition, may be donated to the school for the purpose of recycling to other families. Please wash the clothing before donating.
